Role of executive leaders

- · Ensure ... strong outcomes for all their pupils.
- Ensure that the MAT's financial viability is secure...

Role of executive leaders

CEO – Core Responsibilities

- Strategic leadership Trust values, culture and strategy
- Quality of Education
- · Finance, sustainability and compliance
- People strategy
- Governance and accountability
- System leadership and civic responsibility

The CEO is also the 'Accounting Officer'. This means that they are personally responsible to Parliament for the finances of the trust. Whilst they work with trustees, the Chief Finance Officer (CFO), governors, headteachers and others, the buck stops with them!
